Phlomis fruticosa – evergreen – yellow flowers
Callistemon – Bottle brush – evergreen
Ceratostigma – evergreen – blue flowers
Teucrium fruticans – evergreen – grey leaves, blue flowers
Choisya – Aztec Pearl – evergreen – white flowers
Leptospermum – evergreen – white flowers
Pittosporum – evergreen – scented
Hebe 'Jaspar' – evergreen – flowering

COASTAL SHRUBS – Medium

Genista Lydia – yellow Broom
Euonymus – variegated
