



ABYA MEMBERSHIP GRADES

Associate Members

- Entry-level membership designed for those beginning their brokerage career, or for those wishing to start their own business.
- Requirement: Completion of the ABYA Associate Sales & Purchase Exam and the ABYA Code of Practice Exam, with a minimum pass mark of 80% required for the Code of Practice Exam.

Accredited Members

- Intended for brokers with several years of experience, though not yet at the level of a Full Member.
- Typically working alongside another broker.
- Upgrading from Associate Membership: Existing Associate Members are not required to re-take the ABYA Code of Practice Exam or the ABYA Associate Sales & Purchase Exam.
- Requirement: Complete the Knowledge Assessment, achieving a minimum pass mark of 90%.

Full ABYA Membership

There are two routes to becoming an ABYA Full Member:

Progression from Accredited Membership

Accredited Members may apply to upgrade to Full Membership once they have held Accredited Membership for at least five years.

As part of the upgrade process, applicants are required to successfully complete the following:

- Code of Practice Exam
- Sale & Purchase Exam
- Knowledge Assessment

This ensures that Full Members continue to demonstrate their knowledge and competence against ABYA's current professional standards.

Direct Entry into Full Membership

Brokers who are not currently ABYA Accredited Members may apply directly for Full Membership where they can demonstrate a minimum of 10 years' brokerage experience.

Direct entry applicants are required to successfully complete the following:

- Code of Practice Exam
- Sale & Purchase Exam
- Knowledge Assessment
